SURVIVAL GEAR & SAFETY TOOLS

(Used in fire-starting, search and rescue, wilderness safety)

- Fire starters (magnesium blocks, flint kits, matches)
- Headlamps or flashlights (battery-powered or solar)
- First aid kits (new or fully stocked)
- Emergency whistles
- · Reflective vests
- Compass or navigation tools
- Emergency blankets
- · Signal mirrors
- Multi-tools or Swiss army knives

& CAMPING GEAR

(Used in camping retreats, overnights, and nature workshops)

- Sleeping bags (youth and adult sizes)
- Tents (2–12 person, easy setup preferred)
- Tarps (for ground cover or rain shelters)
- Sleeping pads or camping mats
- Camping stoves (propane, single-burner)
- Cooking gear (pots, pans, spatulas, camp utensils)
- Cooler bags or hard coolers
- Camping chairs
- Camp lanterns (battery-powered or solar)

FISHING GEAR

(Used in basic angling instruction and outdoor recreation days)

- Fishing poles (spinning reels preferred)
- Tackle boxes
- Hooks, lines, sinkers, bobbers
- Bait containers or nets
- Small tackle bags or storage boxes
- Life vests (youth and adult sizes)

CLOTHING & OUTDOOR WEAR

(Used for hikes, field instruction, overnight programs)

- Hiking boots (boys' and men's sizes)
- Waterproof jackets or ponchos
- Wool socks or hiking socks (new)
- Layered outdoor clothing (fleece, long sleeves)
- Hats (wide-brim, baseball, beanies)
- Gloves (waterproof or thermal)

*** LEADERSHIP & WORKSHOP GEAR**

(Used in hands-on skills training and survival instruction)

- Bricklaying or masonry tools (for Briccs program)
- Tool belts or gear bags
- Tape measures, levels, and hammers
- Gardening gloves
- Work boots (lightly used or new)
- Eye protection or safety goggles
- Power tools
- Masonry tables
- Cutting tables

RECREATIONAL & SPORTS EQUIPMENT

(Used in team-building, fitness, and outdoor fun)

- Basketballs, footballs, soccer balls (youth sizes welcome)
- Sports cones and training markers
- Jump ropes
- Archery sets (recurve preferred, with safety tips)
- Frisbees or agility games
- Team pinnies or practice jerseys

BACKPACKS & OUTDOOR STORAGE

(Used for gear distribution, day hikes, and overnight outings)

- Backpacks (school-size and camping-size)
- Waterproof bags or dry bags
- Duffle bags
- Storage bins (plastic with lids, for organizing gear)
